



MEMBER'S AGREEMENT WITH THE CHAPLAIN ALLIANCE FOR RELIGIOUS LIBERTY'S PURPOSE, VISION, STATEMENT OF COMMON FAITH AND OBJECTIVES

The _____, a DOD endorsing agent, agrees with the following Vision, Purpose, Objectives, Statement of Common Faith and Standards of Conduct of the *Chaplain Alliance for Religious Liberty* (the "Chaplain Alliance"):

Vision. A nation in which all chaplains and those whom they serve freely exercise their God-given and constitutionally-protected religious liberties without fear of reprisal.

Purpose: To ensure that chaplains can defend and provide for the freedom of religion and conscience that the Constitution guarantees all chaplains and those whom they serve.

Statement of Common Faith: The *Chaplain Alliance* members believe in, profess and adhere to the following orthodox Christian truths:

- (1) The Bible is the inerrant, infallible Word of God in the original languages and the absolute standard for moral conduct;
- (2) The Trinity;
- (3) The Lordship of Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, born of the virgin Mary;
- (4) Salvation by grace through repentance from sin and faith in the redeeming sacrifice of Christ on the cross;
- (5) The physical resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ, and His Second Coming.

Objectives. The *Chaplain Alliance's* objectives are to:

- (1) Secure the religious liberties of chaplains and those whom they serve.
- (2) Enable all chaplains to serve to the broadest extent of their constitutional mission and/or Endorsement.
- (3) Nurture and support an environment that cherishes the role of chaplains in American culture.

Standards of Conduct: *Chaplain Alliance* members and Officers are expected to:

- (1) adhere to the *Chaplain Alliance* Bylaws and conduct themselves in accord with the principles the Bible establishes for those who call themselves Christians, including self-discipline, honesty and humility. Members agree to resolve any personal wrongs, issues or complaints between themselves and other members in accord with Jesus' command in Matthew 18:15-17 and treat all with the respect due those made in God's image.
- (2) to support the *Chaplain Alliance* and pray earnestly for its success, and for God to exercise His mercy and lead our nation into repentance and revival.
